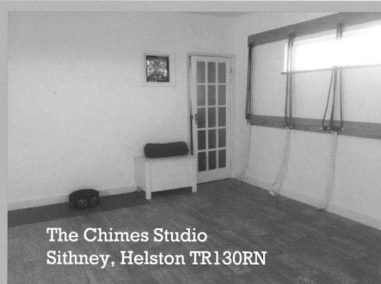
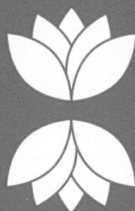

RULES

1. Any entry must have been grown by or be the work of the Exhibitor
Not previously exhibited at Carleen Show
2. Exhibitors may enter only ONE entry in any one class.
3. STAGING: **All staging must be completed by 10.30 a.m.** on the day of Show. Judging to commence at 10.45 a.m. Exhibits cannot be removed until prizegiving is completed.
4. In a case of shortage of space when staging, exhibits may be moved only by a Steward, not other exhibitors.
5. The hall will be open from 7.00-9.00 p.m. on Friday for exhibitors and at 8.00 a.m. on day of Show.
6. ENTRANCE FEES: Adults and Children 20p per exhibit
7. Cash prizes will be awarded in Children's classes only.
1st £2.00 - 2nd £1.50 - 3rd £1.00
8. Prize cards will be awarded for 1st., 2nd., 3rd., In each class.
9. Points will be awarded thus: 3 for 1st, 2 for 2nd, 1 for 3rd.
10. The decision of the Judges will be final. They may withhold prizes if the exhibits are not worthy.
11. The Committee will take ordinary care of the Exhibits but will not be Responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
12. Cups are the perpetual property of the Show and **must be returned** to the Secretaries cleaned and in good condition by **1st August 2026**

81. **RASPBERRY BAKEWELL CAKE**

Ingredients: 140g ground almonds, 140g soft butter, 140g caster sugar, 140g self-raising flour, 2 eggs, 1tsp vanilla extract, 250g raspberries, 2 tsp flaked almonds, icing sugar for dusting.

Method: Heat oven to 180C (160C fan, gas 4). Grease and line the base of a deep 20cm loose-bottomed cake tin. Blitz the ground almonds, butter, sugar, flour, eggs and vanilla extract in a food processor until well combined (or your method of choice). Spread half the mix over the cake tin and smooth over the top. Scatter the raspberries over, then dollop the remaining cake mixture on top and roughly spread. Scatter with flaked almonds and bake for 50 mins until golden. Cool, remove from the tin and dust with icing sugar.

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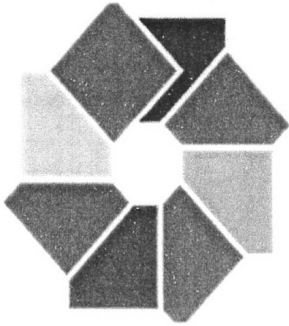
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
